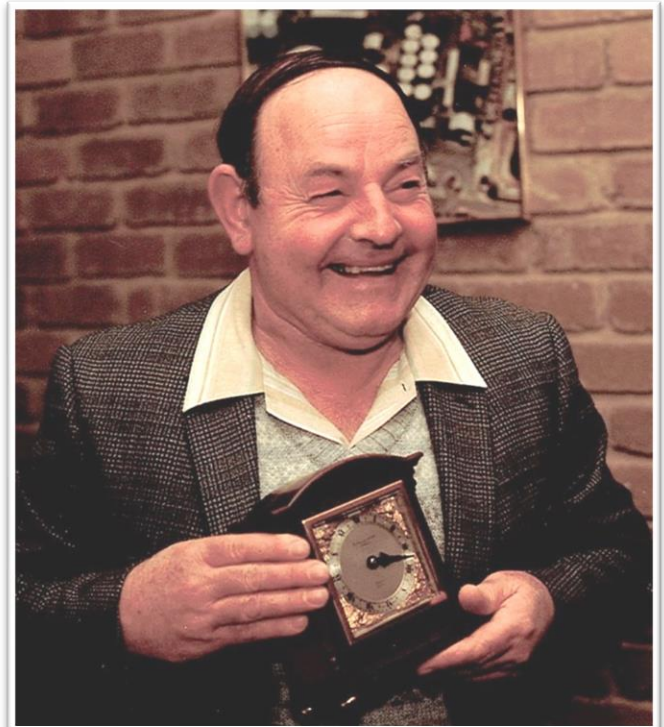
“AFTERGLOW”
