As We Look Back

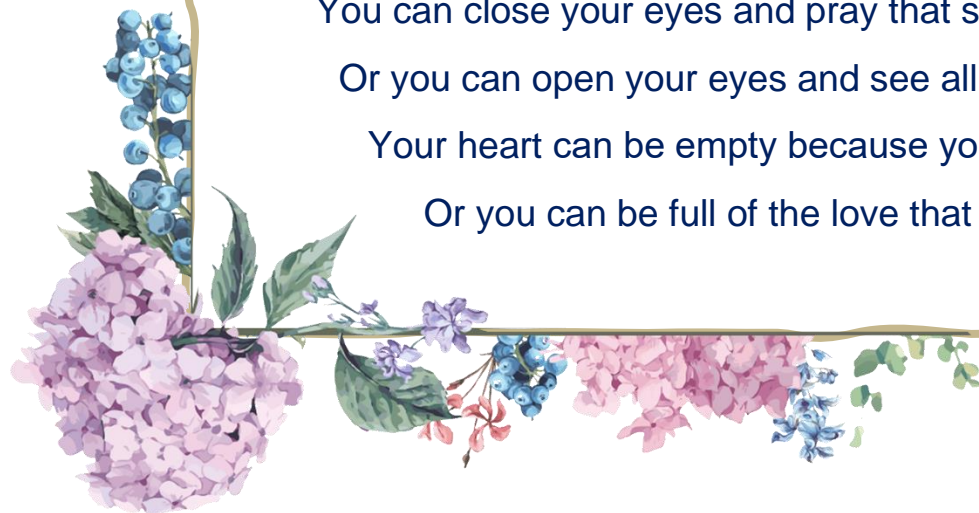

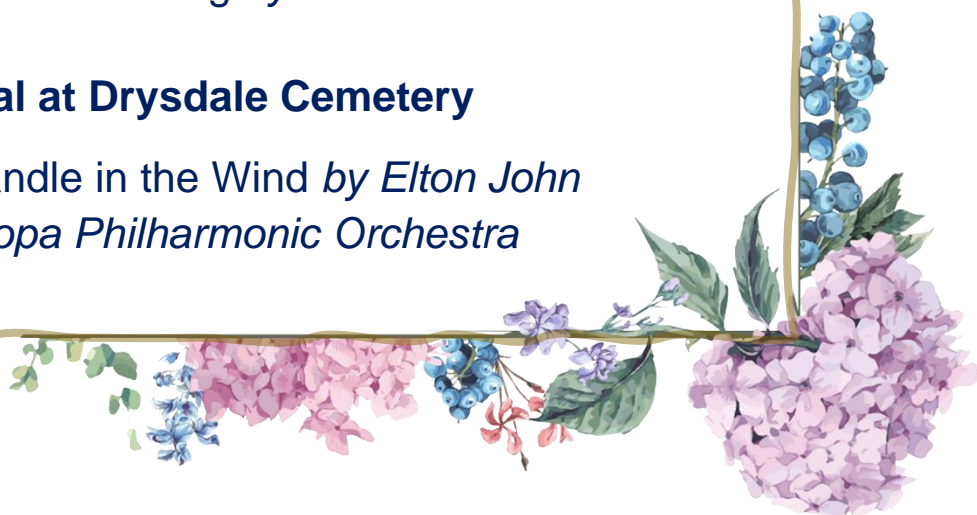
