REMEMBER HIM

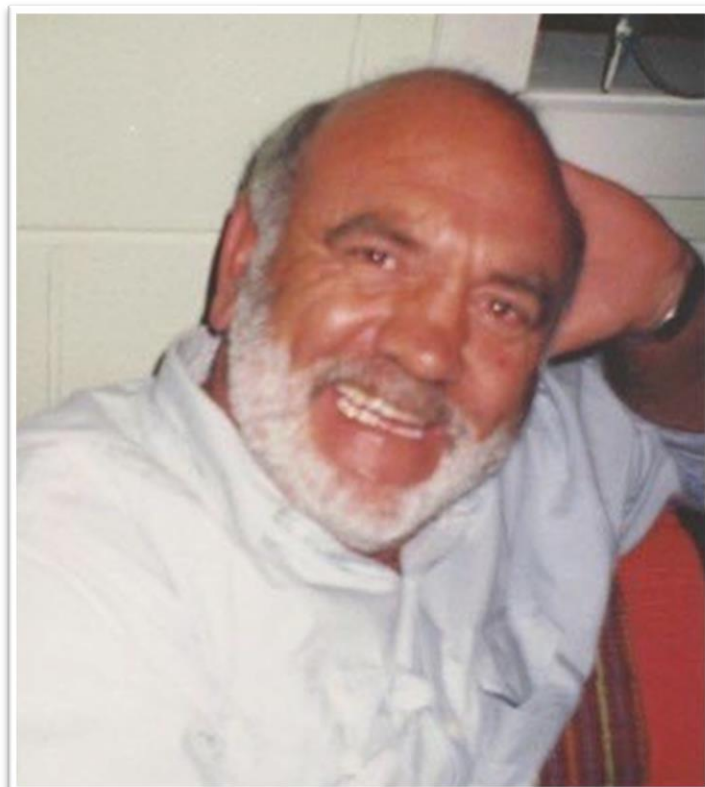
*Remember him with a smile today
